Our plan to overcome this challenge is simple but not easy: attract new parishioners who will support the parish financially and engage in our ministry.

If all of this sounds dire, that's because it is. Dire, but not hopeless. We hope because hope is part of our spiritual DNA as Catholics. We look for signs of hope as we work to rebuild our worship community and to meet the spiritual needs of parishioners and UCSF patients, staff and students now and into the future. Here's *two signs of hope* we see now at St. John of God:

- Thanks to Father Kabipi, a large community of *African immigrant Catholics* has joined us from time to time for Mass. They will now be coming on a more regular schedule, filling the chapel with their lively music and infectious enthusiasm.
- UCSF has informed us we may resume *our ministry of lay volunteers bringing communion to patients and their families* at the hospital. This was suspended at the start of the pandemic. We have already recruited a dozen or so new volunteers!

As people of faith we know the importance of hope. "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer."
