Hurricane Harvey Emergency Collection
September 9/10

Archbishop Cordileone has asked the people of the Archdiocese of San Francisco to respond with open hearts to the millions of victims of Hurricane Harvey in Texas and Louisiana, through a special collection at Sunday Masses on September 10 and vigil Masses September 9. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has issued a national call for Catholics to respond to this "unprecedented and catastrophic" storm with "prayerful and financial support." Archbishop Cordileone joins his brother bishops in asking parishes to participate in this emergency collection. Funds raised will be used both to support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA and to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses through the USCCB.
